

<p>Basic Consultation</p> <p>Comprehensive physical examination and health assessment (During the basic consultation, our vet will be checking on your pet's vitals such as auscultation of the heart and lungs, checking of the body score card (BCS), skin and fur, eyes and ears. <p>Annual Health Check for Vaccination</p> <p>Pre-vaccination health assessment (Before any vaccinations are performed, our vet will check on your pets' physical conditions as well as their main vital organs such as the heart and lungs. If your pet is fit for vaccination, our vet will proceed with the necessary routine injections. If there is any need for other procedures, such as ear cleaning, anal gland expression, diagnostic tests, etc., additional costs are applicable.)</p>	<p>\$25 (Check-up Fee)</p>
<p>First Kitten Health Check</p> <p>Comprehensive first visit examination for new pets (When bringing your kitten in for its first visit to the clinic, a comprehensive health check will be performed. Our veterinarian will conduct a thorough physical examination, assessing vital organs such as the heart and lungs to ensure your pet is in good health. During this visit, guidance will also be provided to help you care for your new puppy or kitten, making the transition into their new home smoother for both you and your pet. If additional procedures are required—such as ear cleaning, anal gland expression, or diagnostic tests—these will incur extra charges. We strongly recommend bringing your new pet to the clinic for an overall health assessment before taking them home, to ensure they are healthy and well. During the visit, our vet will also provide advice on how to care for your puppy, helping both you and your new companion adjust more smoothly to each other and to their new environment. If additional procedures are required—such as ear cleaning, anal gland expression, or diagnostic tests—these will incur additional charges. <p>GENETIC DNA TESTING</p> <p>Comprehensive DNA test for your dog or cat (A DNA test like Wisdom Panel can help pet owners understand their animal's breed mix, which gives insight into behavior, energy levels, and care needs, while also screening for genetic health risks so issues can be monitored or prevented early with a vet. It can be especially useful for mixed-breed or rescue pets with unknown backgrounds, and may help guide diet, exercise, and medical decisions.
